

ORDINANCE NO. 1021

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 90.37 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. HENRY, OHIO ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF PET SOLID WASTE IN THE VILLAGE OF ST. HENRY, OHIO; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this chapter is to protect public health, safety, and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for failure to comply with the proper disposal of pet solid waste.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of St. Henry, County of Mercer, State of Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring that:


SECTION ONE

SECTION TWO


This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


