June 6 - Old Crown Brass Band is based in Fort Wayne, IN, although its members are drawn from a three-state area. They include professional musicians, music educators, music-industry professionals and plain fun-loving amateurs. The idea for the band was conceived by a group of brass

players who were inspired to name the band after a certain beverage brewed by the now-defunct, but oft-remembered, Centlivre Brewing Company – Old Crown Ale. A British Brass Band differs from other wind bands. Reed instruments (such as clarinets and saxophones) are excluded while certain brass wind instruments rarely found in other types of bands (flugelhorns, baritone and tenor horns) are included. The popularity of the British Brass Band movement has resulted in a significant repertoire of original compositions for the brass band as well as custom arrangements of orchestral compositions. June 13 - Green de Villes is a band from Greenville that plays a variety of music. The band covers the music of such artists as Etta James, Beatles, Eagles, Fleetwood Mac, Ozzy Osbourne and Elvis to name a few. The Green de Villes include Cindy Slick (vocals), Will Stacy (bass /vocals), St. Henry native Mike Homan (drums/vocals) and Bill Westfall (guitar/vocals). Electric Light Orchestra was formed in 1970 in Birmingham, England, to create modern rock songs with classical overtones. Turn to Stone: A Tribute to ELO was created to preserve the legacy and music of Electric Light Orchestra for all generations of fans.
